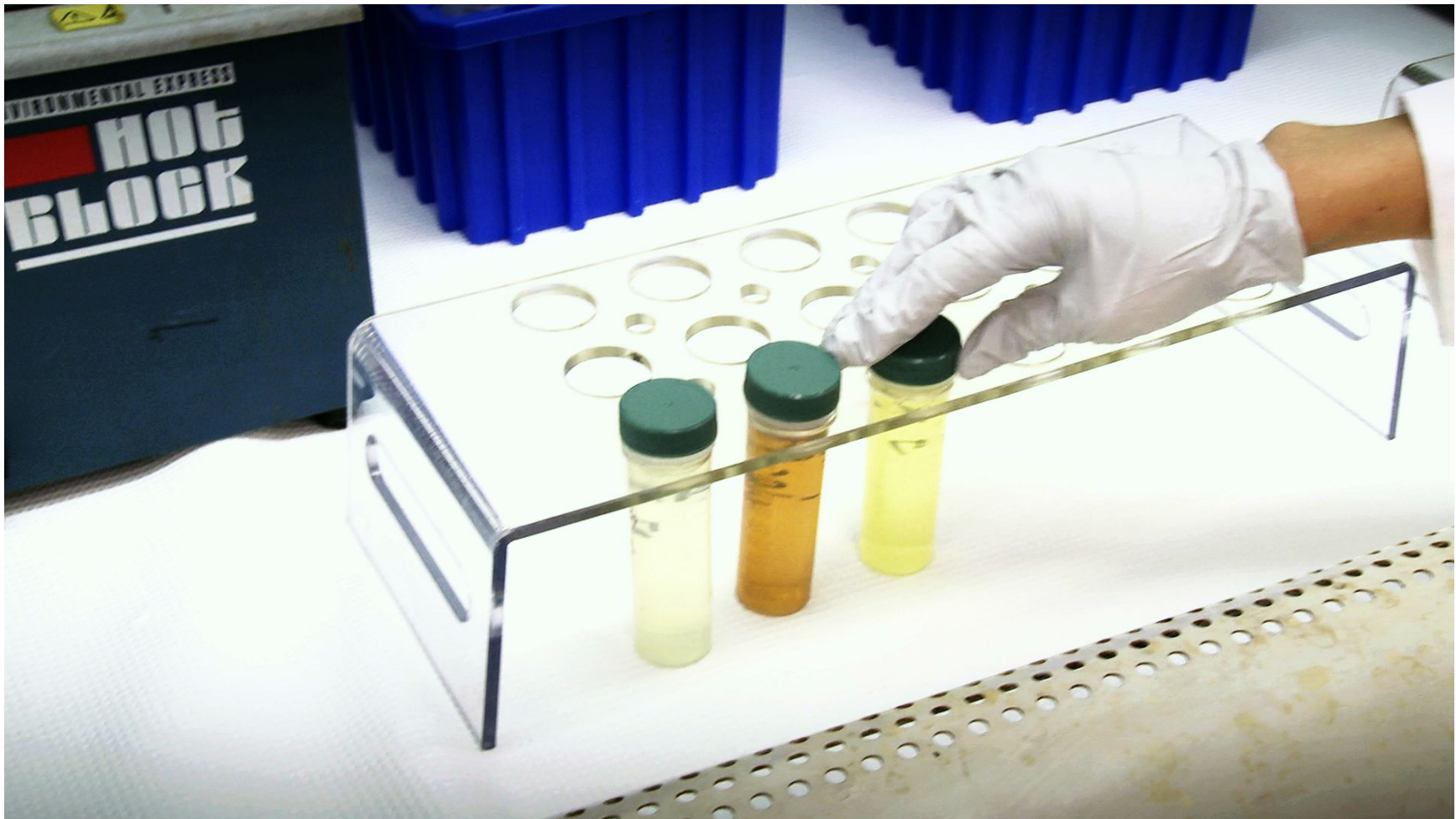

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Cleanup Prioritization:

- Soil sample results
- Schools and child day care centers
- Properties with highest levels of lead
- Properties with highest potential risk of exposure

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After Soil Sampling:

DTSC will meet with property owners and tenants to discuss sampling results, potential health risks and any next steps.

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DTSC will meet with property owners and tenants to discuss:

- How soil excavation will work
- Safety measures
- How to prevent additional contamination

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After Soil Sampling:

Meetings may be held in evenings or on Saturdays
to accommodate people's schedules.
