Three Committees to Hold Oversight Hearing on Toxic Products: Consumer Products Targeted for Action

(SACRAMENTO)— Three of the State Assembly Policy Committee will convene a unique oversight hearing on August 3, 2010 to investigate the State of California's efforts to enforce state laws requiring safe, healthy alternatives to toxic consumer products. The State Assembly environmental committees including those responsible for toxic materials, natural resources and health will hear from consumer groups and activists on consumer choices with special attention on products marketed to young people.

"Californians are demanding strong standards for reducing the use of toxic chemicals in consumer products" said Assemblyman Pedro Nava (D-Santa Barbara), the chair of the Environmental Safety & Toxic Materials Committee. "The oversight hearing will hear from experts from academia, young people finding safer alternatives, State agencies as well as businesses concerned about the widespread use of toxic chemicals in everyday consumer products"
