What is the Ombuds Program?

- An impartial resource for members of the public being impacted by DTSC
- Assists with research, provides information and identifies resources, responds to questions and concerns

What are the limitations of the Ombuds?

- No authority over the Board or DTSC
- No formal investigations
- No legal advice

What is an inquiry?

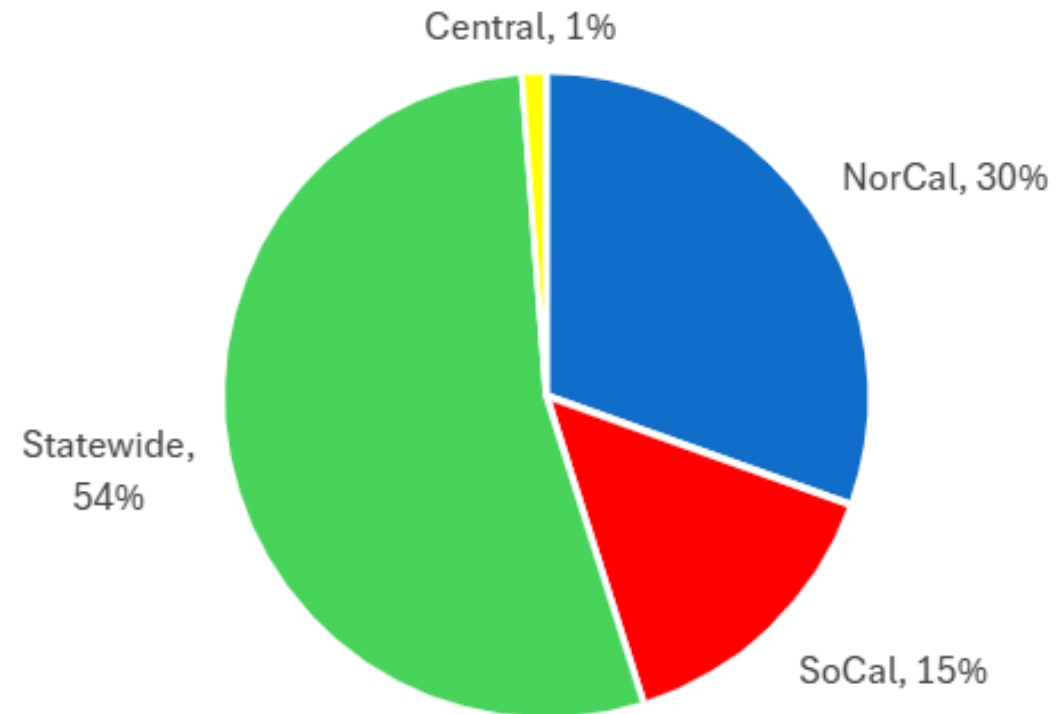
- A request for research, information or answers
- An appeal for systemic review into matters of public interest
- A search for clarification of rights and options

What happens to inquiries?

- Each inquiry is logged internally, then researched for appropriate response
- Inquiries are either responded to directly, or referred to appropriate program for more info
- Resolved items are grouped and analyzed

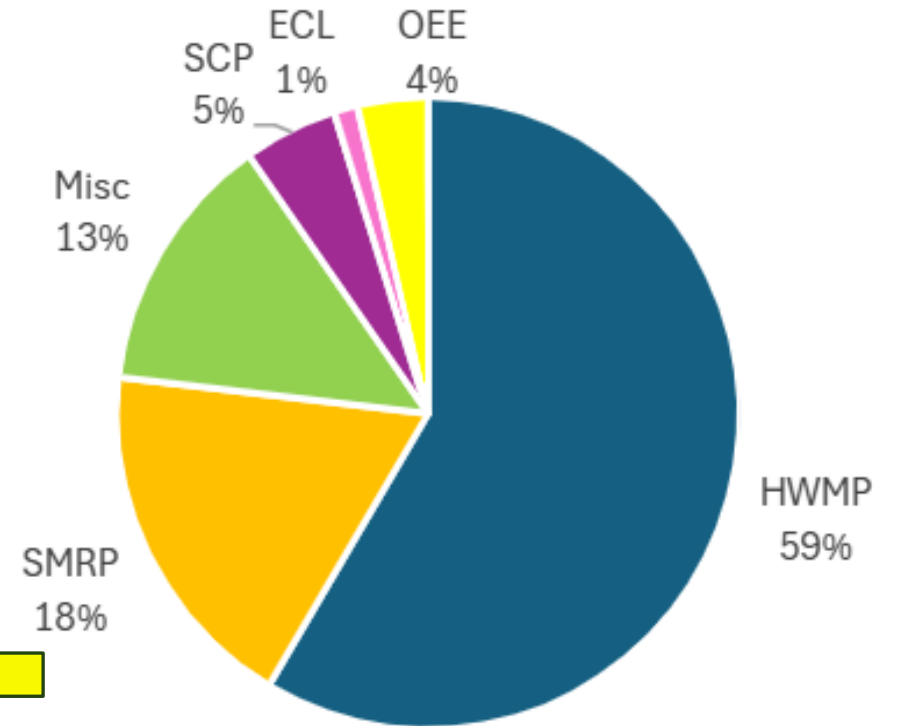
Inquiry Overview (Jan-Dec 2025)

 - Phone – 3

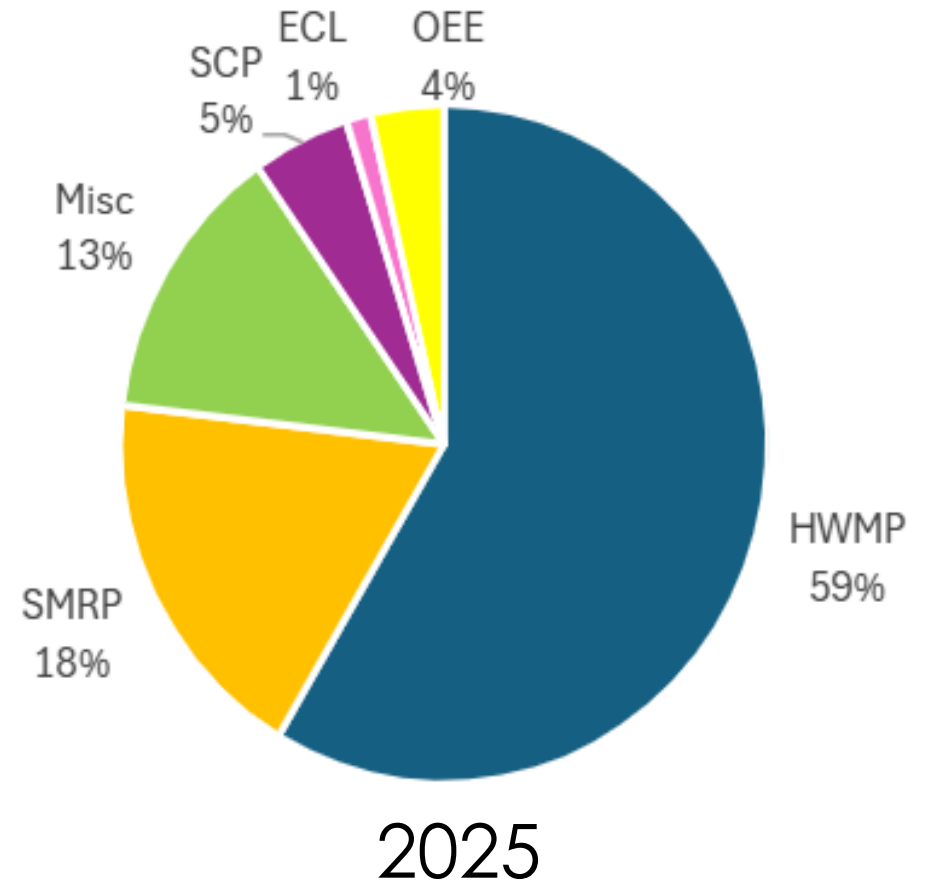
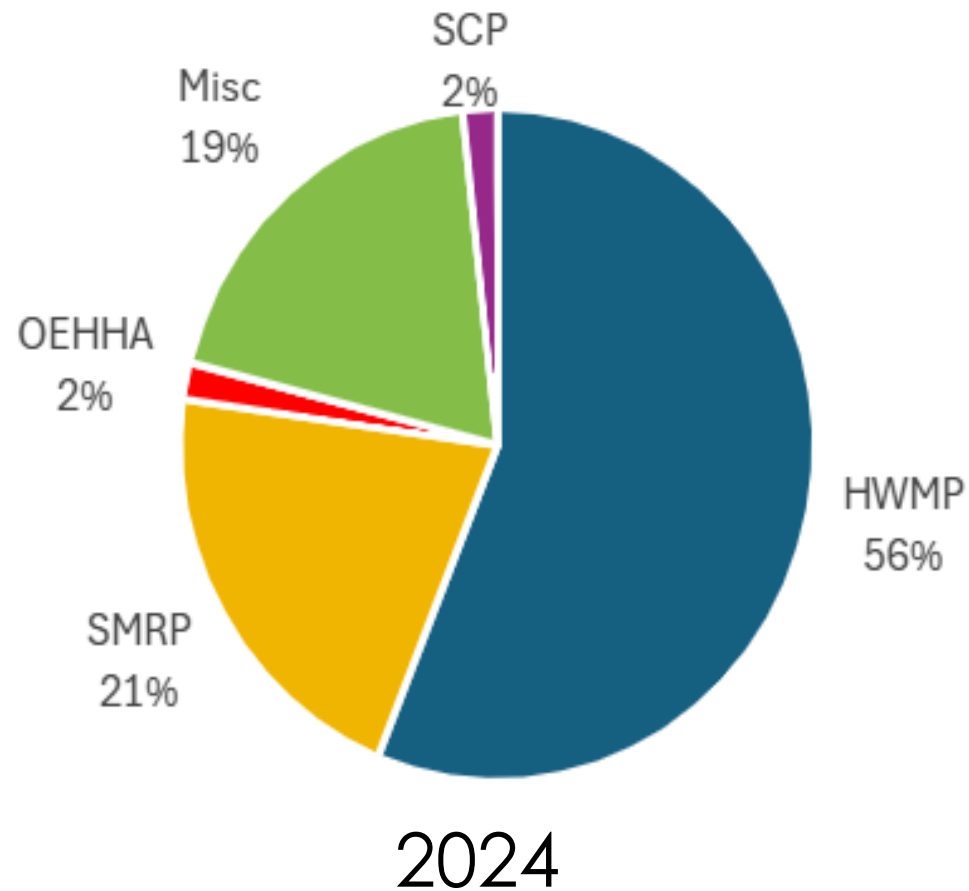


Inquiries By Program (Jan-Dec 2025)

- ECL - Environmental Chemistry Lab (1, 1%) 

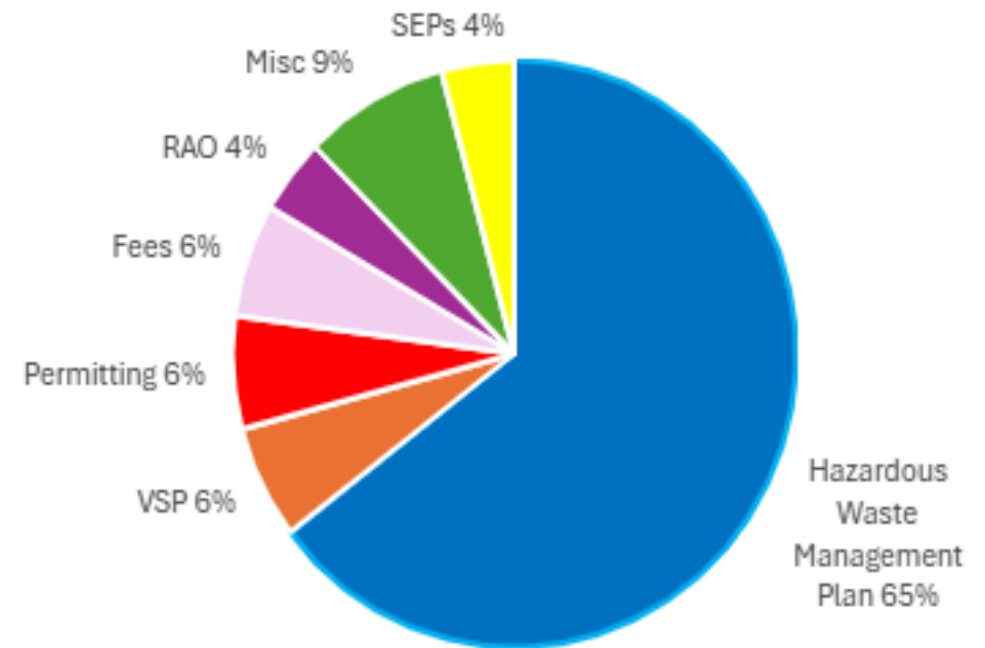


2024 to 2025 Inquiry Comparison By Program

- Improve communication during delays

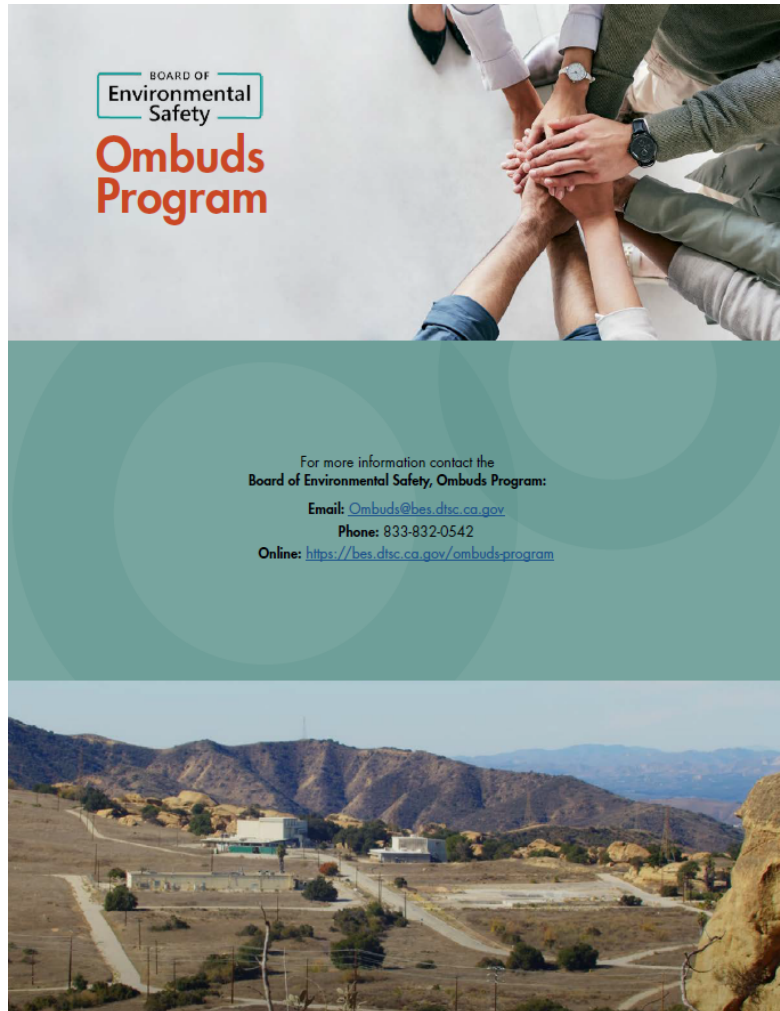
Goals for 2026
